

ACPA OFFERS SPECIAL REPORT ON TEXTURING

The American Concrete Pavement Association has published a new 12-page, 3-color publication entitled "Concrete Pavement Surface Textures." This Special Report covers updated tining specifications (optimized for noise), special textures for hardened pavement, FHWA Technical Working Group findings, and complete texturing recommendations for highways, airports, streets, local roads, parking lots, and loading ramps.

The publication includes recommendations on selecting textures for fresh and hardened concrete, as well as discussions of texture durability and surface friction characteristics. The publication emphasizes the fact that pavement-project feasibility should not be limited by the surface material or texture. The measurement of noise and depth of texture is also covered. The recommendations regarding noise are substantiated by recent research work performed by Marquette University.

The construction of surface textures is also discussed with regard to factors that influence the variability in textures. Hydroplaning is also mentioned as it relates to roadway geometry, drain systems, and environmental conditions. Excellent charts, figures, and photos of surface textures accompany this excellent 12-page special report.
