DESCRIPTION – Entities that manufacture or supply essential materials (other than Portland cement, supplementary cementitious materials, or ready mix concrete) for use by contractors directly in pavement construction, rehabilitation or maintenance are eligible for this category. After joining, all members shall be deemed to have agreed to be bound by the Association's Articles of Incorporation, bylaws, policies approved by the Board of Directors, affiliation agreements with chapters or affiliates of the Association, and all obligations contained in any of those documents. All memberships are considered active unless a resignation letter is received in writing at the Association headquarters office.

The American Concrete Pavement Association (ACPA) is a 501(c)6 organization that serves as the concrete pavement industry's national voice to create and maintain a strong national presence, strategic leadership; effective technical expertise and resources; and persuasive advocacy. For federal tax purposes, contributions to the ACPA are a deductible business expense, with exception of expenses directly attributable to federal lobbying. A statement of the allowable percentage of the deductible expense will be indicated on membership renewal invoices each year.

PLEASE NOTE OUR COMMITMENT TO RESEARCH:

ACPA maintains a commitment to research on behalf of the industry, investing five to ten percent of its budget annually. Any voluntary member contribution designated for research is directed toward on-going research funded directly by ACPA, or is directed to the Innovative Pavement Research Foundation (IPRF), a 501(c)3 organization operated by ACPA for the restricted use of funding research and technology transfer, primarily through the National Concrete Pavement Technology Center. The IPRF applies its efforts on projects that meet the strategic intent of the concrete pavement industry. Priority is given to pooled research programs and filling gaps identified by the Concrete Pavement Research Roadmap.

ACPA is funding the following research and research technology transfer activities:

- ⟨ **Concrete Overlays** – an effort shared by the ACPA and its partner, National Concrete Pavement Technology Center to refine and implement improved guidance on concrete overlays for existing concrete or asphalt pavements. ACPA's contribution is being applied to support of implementation SWAT teams to assist states interested in building concrete overlays, as well as for revision and printing of the Guide to Concrete Overlays document that provides state-of-the-art information to support this technical assistance.
 - ⟨ **Technology Transfer** – ACPA is contributing to a training initiative directed at engineers and agency decision makers that is being undertaken by the National Concrete Pavement Technology Center. The goal is to educate engineers on concrete overlays, concrete pavement preservation, and other high-priority research implementation and technology advancements. In addition, ACPA is developing a training program specifically directed at contractor quality and workmanship issues and that will cover all aspects of design and construction for contractor personnel, including plant operator and certification.
